

Types of Sentences

Declarative Sentence Definition:

A sentence that tells you something or a statement.
It always receives a period.

Example: Ducks eat greedily. The sun shone brightly.

Interrogatory Sentence Definition:

A sentence that asks a question.
It receives a question mark (?).

Example: What time is it? When do we eat?

Imperative Sentence Definition:

A sentence that gives a command.
It always receives a period.

Example: Clean your room. Do the dishes. Come here.

Exclamatory Sentence Definition:

A sentence that shows strong feeling.
A sentence that uses an exclamation point (!)

Example: Welcome home ! You have been missed !
